# 3. The structure of the quali cation

To gualify for the Conjoint Bachelor of Social and Environmental Sustainability and Arts, a studen

- (a) be credited with a minimum total value of 540 points toward the quali cation; and
- (b) be credited with a minimum of 255 points from courses from Schedule V to the Bachelor of Environmental Sustainability regulations; including:
  - i. at least 180 points above 100-level; and
  - ii. at least 60 points at 300-level; and
  - iii. courses listed in Schedule C to the Bachelor of Social and Environmental Sustainability; ar
  - iv. at least 30 points from Schedule E to the Bachelor of Social and Environmental Sustainat regulations including at least 15 points from Group 1 and at least 15 points from Group 2
  - v. the requirements for one major as listed in Schedule S to the Bachelor of Social and Envir Sustainability regulations; and
- (c) be credited with a minimum of an additional 255 points from courses from Schedule V to the Arts regulations; including: cation
  - i. at least 180 points above 100-level; and
  - ii. at least 90 points at 300-level; and
  - iii. two courses from Schedule C to the Bachelor of Arts regulations; and
  - iv. the requirements for one major and one minor, as listed in Schedule S of the Bachelor of regulations. Qu
