# The Degree of Master of Education (MEd – 180 points)

These regulations must be read in conjunction with the General Regulations for the University.

#### 1.Version

These Regulations came into force on 1 January 2025.

#### 2. Variations

In exceptional circumstances the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate may personal programme of study which does not conform to these Regulations.

3. The structure of the qualication

### 3. The structure of the quali cation

To qualify for the Master of Education a student must be credited with a minimum of 180 points towards the quali cation including:

- (a) All courses on Schedule C to these Regulations; and
- (b) Either:

    - b. a minimum of 60 points from Schedule E: Group 1 to these Regulations; or
    - iii. Coursework and thesis
      - a. Either:
        - (i) the courses listed in Schedule S to these Regulations required for the endorsement (thesis pathway); or
        - (ii) EDEM690 and 60 points of courses listed in Schedule V to these Regulations for the unendorsed pathway.

#### 4. Admission to the quali cation

To be admitted to the Master of Education a student must have:

- (a) Satis ed the Admission Regulations for admission to the University; and
- (b) Either:
  - i. Quali ed for an Aotearoa New Zealand bachelor's degree with a major in Education or related discipline, or an equivalent quali cation with a minimum of a B Grade Point Average; or
  - Have quali ed for any other degree of an Aotearoa New Zealand university, and hold a professional teaching quali cation; or
  - iii. Have been admitted with Academic Equivalent Standing; and
- (c) Been approved as a student by the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate.

### 5. Subjects

The degree may be awarded unendorsed or in the endorsements listed in Schedule S to these Regulations.

#### Time limits

The time limits for this quali cation are:

- (a) A maximum of 24 months for a full-time student
- (b) A maximum of 2.2months for a part-time student

- have not already been credited to another completed quali cation, may be transferred to the Master of Education, provided that they satisfy all other regulations of the Master of Education.
- (b) With the approval of the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate, students may be exempt from completing a compulsory course on the basis of equivalent study in a conferred quali cation but are required to complete an approved substitute course to meet overall degree requirements.

## 8. Progression

This quali cation adheres to the General Regulations for the University, with the following stipulations:

- (a) A student may not fail more than 30 points in this quali cation.
- 9. Honours, Distinction and Merit

This quali cation adheres to the General Regulations for the University and may be awarded with Distinction and Merit.

#### 10.Exit and Upgrade Pathways to other Quali cations

- (a) A student for the Master of Education who has not met the requirements but who has satis ed all requirements for the Postgraduate Diploma in Education, Postgraduate Certi cate in Education, or Postgraduate Certi cate in Tertiary Teaching may apply to the Amo Matua, Ako | Executive Dean of Education or delegate to withdraw from the Master of Education and be awarded the Diploma or Certi cate.
- (b) A student who has completed the requirements for the Master of Education, including at least 30 points of independent research, may apply to the Amo Rangahau | Dean of Postgraduate Research for admissic to the PhD or EdD programmes.
