The internationally recognised Erskine programme at University of Canterbury (UC), Christchurch, New Zealand currently supports international senior academics to complete lectures to UC undergraduate and postgraduate students. In the spirit of international cooperation associated with Antarctic research and scholarship, and to recognise

the University of Canterbury has recently created a new Short term Antarctic Visiting Erskine Fellowship programme. This new fellowship will support researchers travelling through

short visits (two to four weeks) to connect with University of Canterbury staff and students.

This Fellowship programme will be administered by the Erskine Programme Office at University of Canterbury and the Director of Gateway Antarctica. Gateway Antarctica is University of class centre for Antarctic research and

teaching, attracting national and international participation in collaborative research, education and outreach that contributes to increased understanding and more effective management of the Antarctic regions.

Short term Antarctic Visiting Erskine Fellowships will be awarded to scholars who are already advanced in the learning of any eligible subject taught in:

- Ø the Faculty of Engineering
- Ø the Faculty of Science

and are provided for the purpose of giving lectures to undergraduate and postgraduate students in such subjects at the University and to build international linkages.
