


	<p>This bird is a Black backed Gull. These birds are able to eat lots of different food. They mainly eat small fish and shellfish but will sometimes eat other birds as well.</p>
		<p>These birds are called Chatham Island Oyster Catchers. They have long red beaks which they use to feed in the tidal zone. They use their beaks to probe and pick molluscs, worms and other invertebrates. They can get limpet shells off rocks using their beaks.</p>
		<p>This is a red-crowned parakeet. It is a type of parrot; it likes to feed on fruit and seeds such as the nectar in the flowers of the flax.</p>
		<p>This is a Chatham Island black robin. It is a very small bird so it can fly between the branches in the forest. This bird likes to feed on insects, spiders and wetas.</p>
